Each year we are humbled by the outpouring of support from the Greater Nashua community – its residents and businesses – who generously support the agency's mission to assist individuals and families transition from crisis to self-sufficiency.

We had a very successful year from a fundraising perspective. Our first Harvesting Change celebration at LaBelle Winery wrapped up our 28th Annual Penny Drive. Tickets for the event, which included a Murder Mystery Dinner, sold out quickly. Coupled with our annual Gourmet Festival, the agency exceeded budgeted revenue goals and effectively managed expenses.

The agency's success certainly lies in the heart of its staff. Their dedication to our mission and those depending on our help is remarkable. They work tirelessly to provide case management for and advocate on behalf of our clients, promote the mission of the agency, and provide sound fiscal management to ensure the funds entrusted with the agency are used wisely.

We would also like to thank the Board of Directors for their tireless commitment to the Front Door Agency in giving of their time, talents and financial resources. I would especially like to recognize outgoing board members Tom Boucher, Mike Gonzales and Chris Malloy for their years of service. They have contributed much to the agency including Tom and Mike's service as President and eight-year board terms.

The support of our donors, business partners, staff and Board of Directors allowed The Front Door Agency to serve a record number of families in need by providing them with basic necessities.

Rent assistance, heat, electricity, security deposits, auto repair, gas cards, prescriptions and other miscellaneous items help ensure that families can remain in permanent housing and maintain employment, bringing stability and dignity to their lives.



We are especially proud of the mothers in our transitional housing program who work very hard with our case managers to bring stability to their lives.

A basic expectation of women in the program is that they enroll in classes to further their education. In addition, many of them work full or part time to achieve their goal of becoming self-sufficient members of our community.

Many mothers and their young children enter the program with nothing more than a desire to improve their lives and the changes we see are transformational!

The Front Door Agency does wonderful work in our community and leaves an indelible mark on the lives of our clients. Your support truly does make a difference and for that we thank you.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Our Integrated Programs Improve Lives in the Community.

Prevention & Intervention of Homelessness

Many times a family has experienced a temporary setback and all they need is "one touch" to get back to independence. We provide one-time or short-term rent and mortgage subsidies and housing placement services for individuals and families in crisis. Preventing homelessness is much more cost effective and less disruptive to families than dealing with homelessness once it has occurred.

Permanent Affordable Housing

The Front Door Agency owns a six-unit property known as Shattuck Place. With this purchase three years ago, we were able to diversify our housing portfolio and offer permanent, affordable housing opportunities to families in need.

Financial Literacy

We offer a five-week basic financial education program free to the community, twice each year. Presented by financial experts from the community, the series is based on the belief that understanding money management is key to achieving



Crisis Advocacy & Resource Education (CARE)

Many individuals and families need only a onetime support to maintain financial selfsufficiency during a crisis. The Front Door Agency offers assistance with car repairs, Medical and dental expenses and other basic needs to qualified applicants — making it easier for them to stay working.



Transitional Housing

The Front Door provides singles mothers and children facing homelessness with affordable housing options and comprehensive support services.

Our three-phase program emphasizes life skills and education. Each year women graduate with certifications and degrees, along with valuable parenting and life skills. They are able to provide for their own families and in many cases, to give back to the community.



PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION OF HOMELESSNESS

- 100% of households receiving assistance through this program in FY15, achieved immediate housing stability.
- 82% of households receiving assistance did not experience an episode of homelessness within the following 12 months.
- 95% of clients receiving security deposit assistance (66 units/159 people) maintained their housing for at least one year.

EDUCATION

The Front Door Agency was pleased to award two scholarships in 2015 from the Dr. Ronald J. Kraus Memorial Scholarship Fund. IN NICOLE'S OWN WORDS

It's been a long journey, but I'm proud to say I am now supporting myself and my family on my own. A big part of my success has been the many caring people who believed in me when I didn't even believe in myself.

When I first came to the Front Door Agency's Transitional Housing Program, I was leaving an abusive relationship. My abuser had isolated me from my family and left me feeling scared, anxious and unsure about our future. At the time, I didn't have career goals; I just wanted to be safe and to keep my daughter safe.

It took a while, but eventually I earned a bachelor's degree in social work from Bridgewater State University with a 3.89 GPA. I am now a licensed social worker for the Massachusetts Department of Children and Familieis and in May 2015, I moved my family into a brand new home of our own.

I know I could not have achieved all this without strong support from the Front Door Agency. The gift of education changed my life!
