A FATHER'S LOVE

Derek never needed help supporting his family. Then the pandemic hit and he lost his job.

Derek is a local chef and the sole provider for his wife and their 13-year-old-daughter. Last year, his job was furloughed because of the COVID-19 pandemic. He received unemployment, but it was nowhere close to his salary. Soon, he fell behind on rent.

"I found myself without my job and in real need, shaking the stability of our family in ways I could not have predicted," Derek said. "We have never asked for assistance before and I was not even sure how to go about doing such."

Derek came to the Front Door Agency and worked with our Housing Stability Program Manager, Doug Howard, to get the assistance he needed to prevent his eviction. "The whole situation was very embarrassing for me," said Derek. "And Doug did everything to not make me feel embarrassed."

Today, Derek is self-sufficient again. "You saved us from a terrible situation that could have included homelessness," he said. "And you did so in the most effective and empowering way."

FRONT DOOR AGENCY EXPANDS AFFORDABLE HOUSING INVENTORY

Earlier this year, the Agency purchased 57-59 Marshall Street in Nashua. The duplex is the sixth property owned by the Agency that offers affordable housing to local families that qualify. The purchase was made possible thanks to funding from the Governor's Office for Emergency Relief and Recovery Shelter Modification Grant, the Episcopal Diocese of New Hampshire, the Ann De Nicola Trust, and the Mary Louise Billings Trust.

AGENCY AWARDED \$125,000 TO ADDRESS RENTAL CRISIS



The Front Door Agency, the leading homelessness prevention provider in Greater Nashua, is one of 32 recipients of this year's TD Charitable Foundation's Annual Housing For Everyone grant. The Agency will use these funds to help local individuals and families through its Housing Stability Program, which offers assistance with most housing-related costs, interest-free security deposit loans, and rapid rehousing.
